

The (A449) Trunk Road (Chester Road North and Stourbridge Road Kidderminster) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 19

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A449 Worcester-South of Stafford Trunk Road, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at all times on both sides of the trunk road from a point 208 metres south of its junction with the A451, Stourbridge Road (known as Chester Road North, Kidderminster) to a point 55 metres east of its junction with Sion Hill (known as Stourbridge Road), a total distance of 371 metres.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein. Exceptions will also be provided for disabled persons' badge holders.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Sheffield-Grimsby Trunk Road (A630) (High Road, Warmsworth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 198

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on those lengths of the A630 Trunk Road (known locally as High Road, Warmsworth) in the district of Doncaster in the county of South Yorkshire as specified below:

- (i) on its northern side—for a distance of 60 metres in a westerly direction from its junction with Grosvenor Crescent, and for a distance of 70 metres in an easterly direction from that junction; and
- (ii) on its southern side—from its junction with the southbound entry sliproad of the A1(M) roundabout, for a distance of 130 metres in an easterly direction.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for:

- (i) the loading or unloading of goods onto or from the vehicle;
- (ii) building, industrial or demolition operations;
- (iii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iv) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the trunk road or the services contained therein; and
- (v) police, ambulance or fire brigade services.

Exceptions are also included for disabled persons badge holders.
