RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS FROM THE NATIONAL LOANS FUND

NOTICE

The Treasury in pursuance of section 5 of the National Loans Act 1968 (as amended) hereby give notice that on or after 12th October 1988:

Licensed Non-residential Establishment Wages Council

The Council gives notice of proposals for new rates of statutory minimum pay with effect from 15th January 1989. The proposed new rates are £2.30 per hour basic rate and £3.45 per hour overtime rate. The limit fixed by the Council for deductions (or payments made by the worker) for living accommodation provided by the employer is £1.40 per day or part of a day.

MEDICINES ACT 1968

European Pharmacopoeia: Approved Synonyms

The Ministers, that is to say the Secretary of State for Health, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health and with agriculture in Wales and in Scotland, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, hereby declare under section 65(3) of the Medicines Act 1968, that the Medicines Commission has approved a list of synonyms for names at the head of monographs in the European Pharmacopoeia. The subject matter of the list shall take effect on 1st December 1988, and all previous lists of Approved Synonyms are hereby withdrawn.

MEDICINES ACT 1968

Addendum 1988 to the British Pharmacopoeia (Veterinary) 1985

The Ministers, that is to say the Secretary of State for Health, the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health and with agriculture in Wales and in Scotland, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland and the Department of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, having on the recommendation of the Medicines Commission caused to be published the Addendum 1988 to the British Pharmacopoeia (Veterinary) 1985, hereby give notice, under section 102(5) of the Medicines Act 1968, that the subject matter contained in the said Addendum shall take effect on 1st December 1988, except that, where a different effective date is indicated in the text in respect of any part of that subject matter, that different date shall be the date for the part of the subject matter to take effect.

For the purposes of section 102(6) of the Medicines Act 1968, the Printer to Her Majesty of all Acts of Parliament have been authorised by the said Ministers to print copies of the subject matter contained in the said Addendum.
