Exemptions in the order allow a vehicle to wait in the bus bays if it is being used for emergency purposes, or to remove traffic obstructions, or for certain other specified purposes. Other exemptions allow vehicles to wait in most other prohibited areas to allow persons to board or alight; goods to be loaded or unloaded; for emergency purposes; for the maintenance of the road or the services therein; or for certain other specified purposes. There are also the usual exemptions for disabled persons' vehicles.

Full details of the restrictions and the exemptions may be obtained by examining the Order. A copy of the Order which comes into effect on 17th October 1988 and related map, may be examined at Newmarket Library, The Rookery, as follows:
