THE TRUNK ROAD (A5) (PENTREFOELAS, CLWYD) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 19

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 40 mph in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL REGULATIONS 1976

Pedestrianisation of part of a highway at Oldham

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of Oldham Metropolitan Borough Council he has made an Order entitled "The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (Metropolitan Borough of Oldham) (No 1) Order 1988". The Order comes into operation on 19th October 1988 and extinguishes any right which persons may have to use vehicles (other than those specified in Schedule 2 to this Order) on a length of Henshaw Street at Oldham Town Centre.
