TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of lengths of Kingsmead East and Milk Street, Bath, to enable development consisting of the construction of new housing development and refurbishment of existing Kingsmead flats to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted by Bath City Council under Part III of the said Act.

The proposed Order will require the provision of new highways and footpaths maintainable at the public expense for which the Highway Authority is to be the Avon City Council.

During 28 days from the 24th October copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the Bath City Council Offices, Abbey Chambers, Bath BA1 1NT, and may be obtained, free of charge, from the Department of Transport (quoting ref. DSW 504135/1/265) at the address stated below.
