TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Stopping up of Highways (County of Bedfordshire) (No.) Order. 198

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, on the application of Richard Beaty (Building Design) Ltd., he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of highway land adjacent to number 134 Chantry Avenue, Kempston, to enable development consisting of a change of use to garden to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Mr. Devonshire by North Bedfordshire Borough Council under Part III of the said Act.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL REGULATIONS 1976

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order entitled "The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (County of Staffordshire) (No. 17) Order 1988".
