SOUTHERN WATER AUTHORITY

Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given, that an application is being made to the Southern Water Authority by J. R. Bevan Esq., Manor Farm, Old Alresford, to vary licence no. 11/42/22.2/39 to abstract water from boreholes at Old Alresford for watercress growing. The variation applied for is to introduce 3 additional boreholes at Grid References (i) SU58513370, (ii) SU58583368, (iii) SU58573361, to allow standby pumping plant to be used on these additional boreholes up to 20,000 gallons per hour each, and to permit up to 10,000 gallons per hour to be sprayed on to the growing crop if required for crop management purposes.

No increase in the total quantities authorised to be extracted under the existing licence is being sought.
