BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Buckinghamshire County Council (Various Road, Newport Pagnell) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire County Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which Order will be to prohibit heavy commercial vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes from using the follow-ing lengths of roads at Newport Pagnell:—

1. Little Linford Lane, from its junction with Wolverton Road and continuing to a point 15 metres west of its junction with the access road to the M1 Northbound Service Area.

2. Wordsworth Avenue from its junction with Little Linford ane to a point 15 metres south of its junction with Chaucer Close.

3. Linford Avenue from its junction with Little Linford Lane to a point 15 metres south of its junction with Greenfield Road.

Exemptions in the Order will permit the following:-

(a) the conveyance of personal goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to any of the lengths of road;

(b) the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to any of the lengths of road or haulage of timber felled upon such lands;

(c) to enable works to be carried out:

(d) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

(e) for garage, service or repairs at premises adjacent to any of the roads.

The proposed Order provides for the revocation of the Buck-inghamshire County Council (Little Linford Lane, Newport Pagnell) (Prohibition of Commercial Vehicles Over 3 Tons) Order 1978.
