### NOTICE OF PROPOSALS FOR A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that The Anglian Water Authority in pursuance of Section 52 of the above Act, have formulated proposals in the form of a draft Licence (No. 6/33/48/185) to abstract water from underground strata (chalk) a total of 201.7 cubic metres per hour, 4840 cubic metres per day and 1,346,850 cubic metres per annum from two boreholes at NGR TF 9460 0080 in the Parish of Watton in the District of Breckland, Norfolk for the purpose of the Authority's public water supply undertaking.

### TOWER HAMLETS LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

#### LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS

#### *The Tower Hamlets (Waiting and Loading Restriction)* *(Amendment No. ) Order 198*

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets propose to make the above-mentioned Order under section 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Part 1, schedule 5, of the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Order would be further to amend the Tower Hamlets (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976, so that in lengths of streets listed in the schedule to this notice;

(a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited at any time;

(b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited at any time;

(c) the sale offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid license issued by the Tower Hamlets Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, will be prohibited.

3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 (a) and (b) above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g. the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" would apply.

4. A copy of the proposed Order, and of the Tower Hamlets (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976 (and of the Orders which have previously amended that Order) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this Notice is published in Room 212, The Town Hall, Patriot Square, London E2 9LN.

6. Any person desiring to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof, to the Borough Engineer, 27 Birkbeck Street, London E2 6LA, within the aforementioned period of 21 days.
