## WATER RESOURCES ACT

### ANGLIAN WATER AUTHORITY

#### Change of use

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to Anglian Water, N.R.A. Unit, by the Cambridge Water Company for a licence to abstract the following quantities of water from the chalk aquifer for water supply purposes: 1,800 cubic metres per hour, 30,000 cubic metres per day, 8,760,000 cubic metres per year at TL 911824 in the parish of Brettenham, district of Breckland and TL 903798 and TL 934814 in the parish of Euston, district of St. Edmundsbury.

The abstractions applicable to each site are:

TL 911824: 900 cubic metres per hour, 15,000 cubic metres per day, 4,380,000 cubic metres per year.

TL 903798: 600 cubic metres per hour, 10,000 cubic metres per day, 2,920,000 cubic metres per year.

TL 934814: 300 cubic metres per hour, 5,000 cubic metres per day, 1,460,000 cubic metres per year.

The application does not involve any new points of abstraction, but is for a change of use.

Abstractions at these points are licensed, as part of the Great Ouse Ground Water Scheme (Licence Nos. 6/33/44/147 and 6/33/42/74) the sites being known as Works 2, 13 and 15 respectively. The application is being made for change of use to public water supply. The existing Great Ouse Ground Water Scheme licence, held by Anglian Water, will be reduced by this equivalent amount concurrent with the granting of the change of use.

A copy of the application and of any map, plan or other documents submitted with it may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Cambridge Water Company, Rustat Road, Cambridge CB1 3QS, at all reasonable hours during the period beginning on 28th March 1989 and ending on 25th April 1989.

#### Notice of Proposals for a Licence to Abstract Water

Notice is hereby given that the Anglian Water Authority in pursuance of section 52 of the above Act, have formulated proposals for a licence to abstract from underground strata (chalk) a total of 236 cubic metres per hour, 5,660 cubic metres per day and 1,561,000 cubic metres per annum from 2 boreholes at NGR TL 879 823 in the Parish of Thetford in the District of Brookland, Norfolk, for the purpose of the Authority's public water supply undertaking.
