TENDERS FOR STERLING TREASURY BILLS

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Securities Office, Bank of England, Threadneedle Street, on Friday, 31st March 1989 at 1 p.m. for sterling Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877 and the National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of £100,000,000.

The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, \pounds 50,000, £100,000, £250,000 or £1,000,000. They will be dated at the option of the Tenderer on any business day from Monday, 3rd April 1989 to Friday, 7th April 1989, inclusive, and will be due 91 days after date.

The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000 and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated and the net amount per cent. (being a multiple of half of one penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates. Notification will be sent on the day of the Tender to the persons whose Tenders are accepted in whole or in part. Payment in full of the amount due in respect of an accepted Tender must be made to the Bank of England by means of cesh

Tender must be made to the Bank of England by means of cash, banker's draft payable through the Town Clearing or by cheque drawn on the Bank of England, not later than 1.30 p.m. on the day on which the relative Bills are to be dated and on which they are to be collected from the Securities Office.

Tenders must be made on the printed forms which may be obtained from the Securities Office, Bank of England.

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury reserve the right to reject any Tenders. (8 SI)

THE NEW TOWN OF MILTON KEYNES

Extinguishment of public rights of way over part of footpath No. 5 in the Parish of Milton Keynes

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under Section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981, proposes to make an order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following route shown coloured red on the map referred to therein:

"That part of footpath no. 5 in the Parish of Milton Keynes commencing from a point marked A on the map at the path's junction with Milton Road (approximately 680 metres north of the access to the Open University) and running in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 1,470 metres to a point marked B on the map which is located at the path's junction with Groveway (City Road H9) (approxi-mately 200 metres west of the access to Wavendon Tower)".

A map showing the rights of way proposed to be extinguished may be inspected at the offices of the Milton Keynes Develop-ment Corporation, Saxon Court, 502 Avebury Boulevard, Central Milton Keynes MK9 3HS during normal office hours. Any objection to this proposal must be made in writing clearly stating all the grounds of the objection and addressed to the Secretary of State for the Environment, (Ref NT/5444/3/10) Room C12/02, 2 Marsham Street, London SWIP 3EB not later than 2nd May 1989.
