#### UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

Statutes made by the Governing Bodies of Lady Margaret Hall College, in the University of Oxford on 24th October 1988 amending College Statutes I, III, IV, VII, X, XIII, XIV and XVI have been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of their having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923.

The purpose of the Statute is to create a new class of Domus Fellow, to reduce the Statutory retirement age for Supernumary Fellows and to allow surplus income from certain trust funds to be used for the general educational purposes of the College. (16 SI)

### DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping Up of Highways (County of Surrey) (No. 4) Order 1989", authorising the stopping up of parts of Station Road, High Street, Rees Road, St. Matthew's Road and an unnamed road at Redhill in the County of Surrey.

Copies of the Order may be obtained, free of charge, on application to the office of the Director (Transport), Departments of the Environment and Transport, South East Regional Office, Federated House, London Road, Dorking, Surrey RH4 1SZ (quoting ref. RSE 5076/35/1/15) and may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the Reigate Town Hall, Reigate, Surrey, and at the Public Library, The Harlequin Centre, Redhill.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the power of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 4th May 1989, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

##### *Proposed Pedestrianisation of Lengths of Various Highways at St. Helens*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the St. Helens Metropolitan Borough Council he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of New Cross Street, Rigby Street and Hamer Street, St. Helens.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of those highways by vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
- (b) in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the said length of highway of any sewer, main pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984.
