Hours of prohibition: 24 hours daily

Thorpe Hall Avenue:**East (Southbound Carriageway):**

from a point 30 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Broadclyst Gardens to a point 15 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Broadclyst Gardens;

East (Southbound Carriageway):

from a point 30 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Burlescoombe Road to a point 15 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Burlescoombe Road;

Broadclyst Gardens:**Both sides:**

from the eastern kerb-line of Thorpe Hall Avenue eastwards for a distance of 15 metres;

Burlescoombe Road:**Both sides:**

from the eastern kerb-line of Thorpe Hall Avenue eastwards for a distance of 15 metres.

Both sides, from a point 15 metres north of the northern kerb-line of St. Andrews Road to a point 15 metres south of the southern kerb-line of St. Andrews Road.

Linton Road,

Both sides, from the southern kerb-line of St. Andrews Road southwards for a distance of 15 metres.

St. Andrews Road:**North side:**

from a point 15 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Richmond Avenue to a point 15 metres west of the western kerb-line of West Road;

from a point 15 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of West Road to a point 15 metres west of the western kerb-line of Linton Road.
