NOTICE OF PROPOSALS FOR A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that the Northern Division of Welsh Water Authority have formulated a proposal for a draft licence to abstract 1.364 Megalitres a day, 497.787 Megalitres a year from Nant Y Flint at National Grid Reference SJ 230 711 in the Community of Northop in the District of Delyn.

The draft licence incorporates a linking clause to licence number 24/67/10/83/G such that the total annual abstraction from the two sources shall not exceed 497.787 Megalitres per year.

NOTICE OF PROPOSALS TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that the Northern Division of Welsh Water Authority have formulated a proposal to vary licence number 24/66/1/38 Variation number 1 to abstract 7.1 Megalitres a day, 1178.6 Megalitres a year from the existing Plas-yr-Esgob boreholes at National Grid References SJ 11256182 and SJ 11326191 in the Community of Llanynys Rural in the District of Glyndwr.

The variation, if granted, is to allow the full discharge of augmentation water into the River Clywd which the Plas-yr-Esgob site (established in 1979 as part of the Clwyd Augmentation and Abstraction Scheme) can support without detriment to the local groundwater levels. The current licensed quantities are 6.0 Megalitres a day, 1000.12 Megalitres a year.
