

*In the Parishes of Cringleford and Keswick in the District of South Norfolk*

Parts of railway embankment, ditches, part of the Norwich-Ely railway and the right to construct and maintain a bridge over railway embankment (all owned by British Rail Property Board) (127, 127A and 129).

*In the Parish of Keswick in the District of South Norfolk*

Parts of railway embankment, beds of ditches and the rights to connect existing ditches into new culverts (owned by British Rail Property Board) (128, 128A and 128B); the right to widen and regrade part of Cantley Stream in grassland and bed and bank of stream (owned by G. P. and Mrs S. M.
