

CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT 1987, PART II

General Safety Equipment: The Approval of Safety Standards Regulations 1987 (SI 1987/1911); Regulations 2 and 3
Notice No. 5

The safety provisions of the standards mentioned below have been approved by the Secretary of State as standards of safety for the purposes of section 10(3) of the Consumer Protection Act 1987. This is a cumulative list of all standards so far approved; those with an effective date of February 1990 are sidelined.

BS 6652: 1985 Specification for packagings resistant to opening by children.	3rd February 1988	This approval relates to the child resistant containers themselves in which any products may be supplied. The Child Resistant Packaging (Safety) Regulations 1986 require that the more hazardous household liquids be supplied in packaging to BS 6652: 1985. The Medicines (Child Safety) Regulations 1975 require solid dose aspirin and paracetamol preparations for retail sale to be enclosed in child resistant containers complying with BS 5321 and the 1976 and 1987 amendments which call up BS 6652.
BS 6684: 1989 Specification for safety harnesses (including detachable walking reins) for restraining children when in perambulators (baby carriages), pushchairs and high chairs and when walking.	1st August 1989
