#### CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Cornwall (Newquay, St. Columb Road and Summercourt) (Clearway) Order 1990*

Notice is hereby given that the council propose to make the above Clearway Order prohibiting the waiting of vehicles at any time on the main carriageway comprised in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule.

The Order will contain exceptions in favour of buses and to allow delivery and collection of postal packets; in connection with statutory powers or duties; building operations; works on roads and services; fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; the avoidance of an accident; or the opening or closing of any gate or barrier affording vehicular access to or from the main carriageway.

Certain existing waiting restrictions in Gannel Road and Trevemper Road, Newquay will be superseded by the new restriction.

#### SCHEDULE

(1) That length of the A.392 road which commences at the roundabout adjoining the north-western end of the Gannel Link Road at its junction with Mount Wise, Newquay, and runs in a generally easterly direction via Lane to a point 400 yards west of the roundabout at Quintrell Downs.

(2) That length of the A.392 road which commences at a point 644 yards east of the roundabout at Quintrell Downs and runs in a generally easterly direction to a point 54 yards north-west of the level crossing at St. Columb Road.

(3) That length of the A.3058 road which commences at a point 210 yards south of the roundabout at Quintrell Downs and runs in a generally south-easterly direction to a point 194 yards north-west of its junction with the Trunk Road (A.30) at Summercourt. (493)

*The County of Cornwall (Newquay) (One-Way Traffic) (Amendment) Order 1990*

*The County of Cornwall (Newquay) (Restrictions on Waiting) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1990*

Notice is hereby given that the Council propose to make the above Orders to impose traffic regulation measures at Newquay, in conjunction with the forthcoming opening of the new Gannel Link Road, as follows:

- (i) to revoke the existing one-way traffic previously imposed on the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule hereto; and
- (ii) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

Provision will be made for the one-way traffic amendments to be incorporated in the county of Cornwall (Newquay) (Consolidation of Restrictions on Driving) Order 1987, and for the waiting restrictions to be incorporated in the county of Cornwall (Newquay) (Consolidation of Waiting Restrictions) Order 1987.

Exceptions to the new waiting restrictions will be provided in favour of disabled persons vehicles in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme and to allow boarding and alighting; loading and

unloading; delivery and collection of postal packets; statutory powers or duties; building operations; works on roads and services; the taking in of petrol etc. from a garage; and funerals.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE

##### *Revocation of existing one-way traffic*

(1) *Crantock Street* (Class III), between its junction with Higher Tower Road/Tower Road and Jubilee Street/St. John's Road.

(2) *Higher Tower Road* (B.3282), between its junctions with Mount Wise and Crantock Street.

#### SECOND SCHEDULE

##### *No waiting at any time*

(1) *Higher Tower Road* (B.3282) between its junction with Mount Wise and Crantock Street.

(2) The realigned length of Tregunnel Hill (Unclassified), from a point 136 yards south of its junction with Mount Wise to its junction with the Gannel Link Road (in place of the previous waiting restriction on the old superseded length of Tregunnel Hill).

(3) *Chynance Drive* (Unclassified), from the centre of its junction with the realigned Tregunnel Hill for a distance of 15 yards in an easterly direction. (494)

*The County of Cornwall (Newquay) (40 m.p.h Speed Limit) Order 1990*

#### SCHEDULE

That length of the Gannel Link Road (A.392) which extends from its junction with Mount Wise for a distance, measured along the said length of road, of 1662 yards in a generally south-easterly direction to its junction with Trevemper Road. (495)

#### DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Devon (Various Streets, Torquay) (Prohibition of Turns) Order 1990*

Notice is hereby given that Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

When the proposed Order comes into effect you will not be permitted to:

- (1) cause any vehicle or combination of vehicles exceeding 20 feet (6.1 metres) in length proceeding in Shedden Hill to make a left-hand turn into Torbay Road. The existing total prohibition on the left-hand turn will be revoked;
- (2) cause any vehicle proceeding in Shedden Hill to make a right-hand turn into Belgrave Road.

There will be exemptions in the Order for emergency vehicles.
