- 1. An Order under sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980, which will provide that roads which he proposes to construct along the following routes shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into force:
 - (a) A route (the main route) about 3.28 kilometres in length within the London Borough of Havering and the Borough of Thurrock in the county of Essex between a point on the A13 Trunk road, 590 metres north-west of its junction with Purfleet Road and a point on that Trunk road at the M25 Junction 30 roundabout, and

- (b) Four routes for slip roads to connect the proposed main route with other highways at the proposed London Road interchange and the M25 Motorway Junction 30 roundabout;
- An Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:
 - (a) To improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
 - (b) To stop up highways,
 - (c) To construct new highways,
 - (d) To stop up private means of access to premises, and
 - (e) To provide new means of access to premises,

all within the Borough of Thurrock in the County of Essex and providing for the transfer of all but one of those highways to Essex County Council (who will become the highway authority responsible for them), as from the respective dates on which he notifies that council that each highway has been completed and is open for through traffic; and

3. an Order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980, the effect of which is to provide that the length of the London-Tilbury Trunk Road (A13) to be superseded by the new trunk roads described at 1 above shall cease to be a trunk road and shall be classified as a principal road as from the date on which notice is given by him to Essex County Council (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the proposed said new trunk roads are open for through traffic.
