Proposed Stopping-up of a Length of Highfield, Towerhill, Kirkby, Merseyside

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of Merseyside Improved Houses Special Projects Housing Association he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of a length of Highfield, Towerhill, Kirkby, Merseyside, to enable residential development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Ravenscroft Rebuild Co-operative.

The proposed order will require the provision of a new road maintainable at the public expense, for which the highway authority is to be the Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council.
