#### (v) Knighton Road:

- (a) The south and east sides between a point 40 metres east of its junction with Queens Road and a point 23 metres south of its junction with Eton Close.
- (b) The east side between its junction with Chapel Lane and a point 10 metres North thereof.
- (c) The west side:
  - (1) Between its junction with Chapel Lane and a point 10 metres north thereof.
  - (2) Between points 10 metres south and 10 metres north of its junction with Newmarket Street.

  - (2) Newmarket Street, between its junction with Gilliver Street and its junction with Knighton Road, in the direction of Knighton Road.
