The North Cornwall District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that on 30th March 1990, the North Cornwall District Council made the above Order in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order is to amend the North Cornwall District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1989, relating to the increase of some charges; the introduction of new concessionary tickets following the introduction of the Community Charge, and the removal of the restriction on the maximum number of concessionary tickets.

The Order will come into operation on 9th April 1990.
