Proposed Stopping-up of part of a Highway at Oldham

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The A556 Trunk Road (Rostherne Layby) Prohibition of Driving Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport, has made an Order under sections 1(1)(a), (b) and (c) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A556 trunk road at Rostherne in the Borough of Macclesfield, Cheshire.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit access to or use of the Rostherne Layby, on the west side of the A556, just south of the A556/A56 Bowdon Roundabout, except for the inspection and weighing of vehicles by the police, Department of Transport, or Cheshire County Council. There will be exemptions for emergency services (fire, police, ambulance).

The other laybys on each side of the A556 here will remain available for public use.
