Great George Street from Upper Cleminson Street to the rear of the northerly footway of Cleminson Street. Garden Lane, Salford, 3—Garden Lane from Greengate to its cul-de-sac end. Jackson's Place and adjacent passageways, Salford, 3—Jackson's Place from St. Stephen Street to its cul-de-sac end. Passage to the rear of former 2/4 Jackson's Place. Passage to the rear of former 2/4 St. Stephen Street. Part of Cannon Street, Salford, 3—Part of Cannon Street, 45 metres south east of Silk Street, an area of approximately 100 square metres. Any person who has an interest in land abutting on or served by the said highways or uses the said highways or is otherwise aggrieved has a right to be heard by the Court on the hearing of this application by the Council.
