Notice of application for licences to obstruct or impede the flow of an Inland Water by means of impounding works and to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the North West Region National Rivers Authority by Norweb Plc, Registered Office, Talbot Road, Manchester M16 0HQ for licences to obstruct or impede the flow of Glenridding Beck, Glenridding, Cumbria by means of a dam to create a head-pond containing a pipeline intake at National Grid Reference NY 363173, Patterdale parish and to abstract: 0.32 million gallons of water per hour, 7.6 million gallons of water per day, 1,600 million gallons of water per year from the said inland water at or near that point. The capacity of the reservoir at overflow level will be sufficient to keep pipe intake submerged.

Burnett Limited, of Staythorpe House Farm, Staythorpe, Newark, Nottinghamshire, for licences to abstract the following quantities of water, and to vary existing licences, the details of which are as follows:

- (1) New licence to abstract 60 cubic metres/hour, 1200 cubic metres/day, 50,000 cubic metres/year from the river Trent at NGR SK 765529, in the parish of Staythorpe, Nottinghamshire.

- (5) Licence 3/28/69/9/SG/R to abstract from River Gravels and the River Trent at North Muskham, Newark at NGR's SK 791577, 801578, 802581 and 805567 to be increased from 55 cubic metres/hour to 60 cubic metres/hour, 455 cubic metres/day to 1200 cubic metres/day, 27,272 cubic metres/year to 75,000 cubic metres/year. Additional water to be taken from the River Trent.

Further details of the application are: All water is to be used for spray irrigation purposes.
