THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Maentwrog-Bettws-y-Coed-East of Conway Trunk Road (Llanrwst By-pass and other Diversions) (Part Revocation) Order 1990.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 10 of the Highways Act 1980, the effect of which is to revoke:

- (v) Part III of the Schedule.

to the Maentwrog-Bettws-y-Coed-East of Conway Trunk Road (Llanrwst By-pass and other diversions) Order 1953.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highway Act 1980 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks from 20th April 1990, or within 6 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, if such period shall expire later, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road (A483) and the Shrewsbury-Dolgellau Trunk Road (A458) (Welshpool North-South Relief Road and Raven Square side Roads) Order 1990.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
- (b) to stop up a highway;
- (c) to construct new highways;
- (d) to stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) to provide new means of access to premises.

at Welshpool in the county of Powys and providing for the transfer of the said new highways to the County Council of Powys as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Order and of the relevant plan together with copies of the Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road (A483) and the Shrewsbury-Dolgellau Trunk Road (A458) (Welshpool North-South Relief Road) Order 1988 and the Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road (A483) and the Shrewsbury-Dolgellau Trunk Road (A458) (Welshpool North-South Relief Road) (Variation) Order 1988, (both with their accompanying plans) may, be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 20th April 1990 to 1st June 1990 at the offices of Powys County Council, County Hall, Llandrindod Wells; Montgomeryshire District Council, Council Offices, Severn Road, Welshpool and at the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Phase 1, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff.

Any person may not later than 1st June 1990 object to the making of the Order by notice to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Phase 1, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, quoting ref. ZB 750158/311/3 and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any

objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
