**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

*The Trunk Road (A40) (Prendergast, Haverfordwest, Dyfed)  
(Prohibition of Right Hand Turns) Order 19*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit any vehicle travelling in that length of the London-Fishguard Trunk Road (A40) known as the Prendergast Hill Relief Road at Haverfordwest to make a right hand turn at its junction with Well Lane.

The restrictions are currently in force by virtue of The Trunk Road (A40) (Prendergast, Haverfordwest, Dyfed) (Temporary Prohibition of Right Hand Turns) Order 1990, which will be revoked by the proposed Order.

*The Trunk Road (A487) (High Street, Porthmadog, Gwynedd)  
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order*
