

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dorset (Various Streets Lyme Regis) (Traffic Management) Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that the Dorset County Council have made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2) and 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Act 1984.

When the Order comes into effect on 27th April 1990 the effect will be to:

- (a) Where appropriate to revoke parts of previous Traffic Regulation Orders in relation to various streets in Lyme Regis.
- (b) Limit waiting to 45 minutes (return prohibited within 1 hour) 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., on part of Broad Street.
- (c) Limit waiting to 2 hours (return prohibited within 1 hour) 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., 1st June to 30th September each year on part of Hill Road.
- (d) Prohibit waiting at any time on parts of the following roads:
 - (i) Pound Street
 - (ii) Hill Street
- (e) Prohibit waiting at any time between 1st April and 30th September each year of the following lengths of roads:
 - (i) Cart Road—for its entire length and
 - (ii) Parts of Cobb Road, Marine Parade and Hill Road.
- (f) Prohibit waiting at any time with loading and unloading prohibited between 10.30 a.m. and 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. and 5 p.m. from 1st June to 30th September each year in part of Broad Street.

Exemptions will permit waiting for, picking-up or setting down passengers, (subject to (f) above, loading or unloading goods, disabled persons vehicles bearing the relevant "orange badge", post office vehicles delivering or collecting mail, emergency service vehicles and where necessary, in connection with any building or demolition operation, the maintenance of the road, the supply of gas, water or electricity and work to any telegraphic line.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of road affected are available for inspection during normal office hours, Monday to Friday at Transportation and Engineering Department, Dorset County Council, County Hall, Dorchester and West Dorset District Council, Council Offices, Mountfield, Bridport.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date of this notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

DOVER DISTRICT COUNCIL

Dover District Council (Off-street Parking Places—1976) (Amendment No. 1) Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that the Dover District Council, with the consent of the Kent County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 32 and 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to:

- (a) Control the use of off-street car parks to be provided at Pencester Road (cars) and Castle Hill (coaches), Dover.
- (b) Extend the area of the off-street car parks at Russell Street, Dover, and Union Road/High Street, Deal, and introduce control over their use.
- (c) Revise the parking charges in accordance with the attached Schedule.
- (d) Revise season ticket and resident permit charges in accordance with the attached Schedule.
- (e) Reduce the maximum stay at the following car parks to 2 hours: Ladywell and Priory Road, Dover.
- (f) Limit the maximum refund of parking charges to persons parking in the Woolcomber Street and Swimming Pool, Dover, and using the Dover Leisure Centre to 2 hours.
- (g) Delete from the Order the former temporary parking place at Queen Street, Dover.

A copy of the proposed Order, statement of reasons and relevant plans may be examined during normal office hours at Area Office, Maison Dieu Road, Dover; Area Office, Town Hall, Deal; Council

Offices, Honeywood Road, Whitfield, or the Highways and Transportation Department, Kent County Council, Sandling Block, Maidstone.

If you wish to object to any of the proposals you should send the grounds for your objection, in writing, to the undersigned by not later than noon on 21st May 1990.
