The principal effects of designation are:

- (1) that an application for the development of land which would affect the character or appearance of the Conservation Area will be subject to the special procedure referred to in section 28 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971; and
- (2) that with certain exceptions:
 - (a) no building may be demolished, altered or extended without the Council's written consent; or
 - (b) no tree may be cut down, topped, lopped or uprooted without the Council's written consent or wilfully damaged or destroyed.
