

## TRAFFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Trafford (Flixton Road B5158, and Carrington Road B5158) (7.5 Tonnes Gross Weight Restriction on Goods Vehicles Except for Access) Order 1990.*

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd May 1990, the Trafford Borough Council made the above-named Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle, the gross weight of which exceed 7.5 tonnes proceeding along the following lengths of roads, except for access:

*Flixton Road (B5158)*, from its junction with Carrington Lane-Manchester Road (A6144) to its junction with Carrington Road.

*Carrington Road (B5158)*, from its junction with Flixton Road to a point opposite the south-easterly kerb-line of Lansdown Road (a distance of approximately 30 metres).

The Order will come into operation on 25th May 1990, and a copy, together with a map showing the lengths of roads to which it relates, may be inspected at the Information Office, Trafford Town Hall, Stretford, between the hours of 8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m., Monday to Friday.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 25th May 1990, apply to the High Court for that purpose.

*Length of road at South Shields in the Borough of South Tyneside Whiteleas Way:*

West side from its junction with Galsworthy Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 20 metres.

East side from its junction with Nevinston Avenue in a southerly direction for a distance of 50 metres.

East side from a point 61 metres south of its junction with Nevinston Avenue in a southerly direction for a distance of 4 metres.

East side from a point 113 metres south of its junction with Nevinston Avenue in a southerly direction for a distance of 58 metres.

East side from a point 211 metres south of its junction with Nevinston Avenue in a southerly direction for a distance of 3 metres.

East side from a point 251 metres south of its junction with Nevinston Avenue in a southerly direction for a distance of 40 metres.

East side from its junction with Gainsborough Avenue in a northerly direction for a distance of 14 metres.

East side from its junction with Gainsborough Avenue to its junction with Landseer Gardens. (524)
