TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order with modifications under section 209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Tyne and Wear) (No. 11) Order 1990" authorising the stopping-up of various unnamed highways between the link road connecting Southgate Roundabout and Northgate Roundabout and Citadel East, Killingworth, Newcastle upon Tyne, consisting of carriageway and footway to enable development consisting of town centre redevelopment including demolition and new build to provide a Town Square and a mix of retail and office uses to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Makepeace Universal (Killingworth) Ltd. by North Tyneside Council under Part III of the said Act.

NATURAL MINERAL WATERS REGULATIONS 1985

Notice is hereby given that, in response to an application from Farris A/S, Larvik, Norway, the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food has granted recognition to the water originating at King Olav's Spring, Larvik, in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 1 Part II of the Natural Mineral Waters Regulations 1985.

The Minister has granted recognition on the grounds that the Norwegian Institute for Water Research has certified that it is satisfied as to the matters set out in paragraph 2 of Schedule 1, Part I of the Regulations and that regular checks will be made on the matters specified in Schedule 2 of the Regulations.

The recognition of the water took effect from 9th May 1990.
