HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The County Council of West Glamorgan (A4067/A4217 Cross-Valley Link at Pentrechwyth Classified Roads) (Side Roads) Order 1989

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has confirmed the above Order which was made by the County Council of West Glamogan under sections 14 and 125 of th Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council:

(a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;

(b) to stop up highways;

(c) to construct new highways;

(d) to stop up private means of access to premises,

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road which the Council are proposing to construct between the A4047 at Landore and the A4217 at Hafod together with a bypass to route A4217 at Pentrechwyth.

Copies of the Order as confirmed and of the relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at the offices of the West Glamorgan County Council, County Clerk's Department, County Hall, Swansea and at the Welsh Office, Legal Division, Cathays Park, Cardiff.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 18th June 1990 apply to the High Court for the

suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The County Council of West Glamorgan (A4217 Cross-Valley Link at Pentrechwyth Classified Road) (Construction of Bridge over Navigable Waters) Scheme 1989.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has confirmed the above Scheme which was made by the County Council of West Glamorgan under section 106(3) of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council to construct a new bridge over navigable waters known as the River Tawe within the City of Swansea.

Any person aggrieved by the Scheme and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Scheme, may within 6 weeks from 18th June 1990, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Scheme or of any provision contained therein.
