The Stopping-up of Highways (Park Slip West, Cefn Cribwr, Mid and West Glamorgan) Order 19

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes, subject to the granting of planning permission, to make an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and section 32 of the Mineral Workings Act 1951, to authorise the temporary stopping-up of the highways described in the Schedule to this notice, for a period of 7 years, to enable further development by the British Coal Corporation at the Park Slip West Opencast Site, near Cefn Cribwr, Bridgend, in the counties of Mid and West Glamorgan.

The proposed Order requires the provision of a new highway which will be maintainable at public expense, and for which West Glamorgan County Council shall be the highway authority.

During the 28 days from 21st June 1990 copies of the draft Order and the relevant plan may be inspected free of charge at:

Within the above-mentioned period of 28 days any person may by notice to the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL (quoting ref. ZC510-5-0-1), object to the making of the Order. In the preparation of an objection, it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

The highways to be stopped-up are at Park Slip West, Cefn Cribwr, in the counties of Mid West Glamorgan. They are shown by zebra hatching on the deposited plan and are:

- (1) That part of Bedford Road which extends from its junction with the unclassified Pen-y-bryn to Tondy Road, known as New Road, in a southerly direction for a distance of 962 metres.
- (2) That part of Crown Road which extends from its junction with Bedford Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 472 metres.
