CLEAN AIR ACT 1956 AS AMENDED BY

LOCAL GOVERNMENT PLANNING AND LAND ACT 1980

The Kingston-upon-Hull No. 22 (North West) Smoke Control Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that the Kingston-upon-Hull City Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 as amended by the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980, having on 7th June 1990 given public notice of an intention to make the above-named Order and having considered an objection to the proposed Order has made the said Order without modification, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area. The date of operation of the Order will be 1st December 1990.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of a building within the Smoke Control Area, the occupier of that building will be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding four hundred pounds (£400) unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any other fuel than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke, phurnacite, coalite, raxco, roomheat, homefire, gas, electricity and various carbonised fuels.
