Falmouth，Nov．g．

HEre are now in Port two French Ships bound for the Iflands near Cape de $V_{f} r d$ ． A fmall Veffel of this Harbor newly returned from Burdcaux，informs us，That there are not in the Garonne above Fifty Fifl of Dutch Ships，which is fcarcely a third，part of the number formerly employed thither，and thefe with much difficu＇ty freighted．

Tumosth，Nov 14．Yefterday arrived here from Rottertin，eight Veffels belonging to this Town， the people on board them report，That a prodigious number of Water Mice iwinming over the Macs， filled the Countray between Rotterdam and Sqbie－ dam，and Jeftroved the：r Grafs，Herbs，and Plants， and apmow zot into the Town of Rotterdam，infelt－ ingethdtuects and Houles．
yterfaro．Ofot．25．Sunday the 19th inftant be－ ing the day appuinted for the folemnity of the Quecus Coronation，as a prelude to that grear Ce － remony；Tweive Guns which were planted upon the Wiftula，were fircd the evening before，about the mone of their Majefties going to bed，which were 2a－s fwered by Twenty four others from the Arfentr，which ．was again repeated at the break of day on Sunday moraing；about Eleven of the clock his Majeity clad in his Royal Robes，the Crown uponhis head，and the Scepter and Golden Sphere in his hand，went in the following order to $S$ f jfohns Church，the foldi－ ers being plactd in two rapks in the ftreets by which he was to pals，from the Palace to the Church ；Fird marched the M mbers of the Lower Chamber of the Diet，congiging of the Noblefs，and Daputies from the feyent farts of the kingdom and from the Army， next to them the Sanators and Officers ofughe king－ dom ；and theprthe Marfhals of the Cxown，and of Fy fhuinja：pfter thefe the Syby bearemof the Crown
