PROCLAMATION

BY THE QUEEN

APPOINTING WEDNESDAY 26th DECEMBER 1990 AND MONDAY 27th MAY 1991 AS BANK HOLIDAYS IN SCOTLAND AND TUESDAY 1st JANUARY 1991 AND MONDAY 6th MAY 1991 AS BANK HOLIDAYS IN ENGLAND, WALES AND NORTHERN IRELAND.

Whereas We consider it desirable that Wednesday, the twenty-sixth day of December in the year 1990 and Monday, the twenty-seventh day of May in the year 1991 should be bank holidays in Scotland:

And whereas We consider it desirable that Tuesday, the first day of January and Monday, the sixth day of May in the year 1991 should be bank holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland:

Now, therefore, We, in pursuance of section 1(3) of the Banking and Financial Dealings Act 1971, do hereby appoint Wednesday, the twenty-sixth day of December in the year 1990 and Monday, the twenty-seventh day of May in the year 1991 to be bank holidays in Scotland and Tuesday, the first day of January and Monday, the sixth day of May in the year 1991 to be bank holidays in England, Wales and Northern Ireland.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace this seventh day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and ninety and in the thirty-ninth year of Our Reign.

TENDERS FOR STERLING TREASURY BILLS

1. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Securities Office, Bank of England, Threadneedle Street, on Friday 6th July 1990 at 1 p.m., for sterling Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877 and the National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of £500,000,000 for Bills due 91 days after date and £200,000,000 for Bills due 182 days after date.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, £50,000, £100,000, £250,000 or £1,000,000. They will be dated at the option of the Tenderer on any business day from Monday 9th July 1990 to Friday 13th July 1990, inclusive.

3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than £50,000 and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated and the net amount per cent. (Being a multiple of half of one penny) which will be given for the amount applied for. Separate Tenders must be lodged for Bills of different dates and different tenors.
