The Borough of Dacorum (Waterhouse Street, Bridge Street, Hemel Hempstead) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that Dacorum Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with the Hertfordshire County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and 2(3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which will have the following effect:

1. To revoke the following:

- That part of Schedule 2 of the Borough of Hemel Hempstead (Vehicle Parking Places) Order 1963, relating to Waterhouse Street, Hemel Hempstead (The Taxi Rank).
- Item 19 of the Third Schedule to the Borough of Hemel Hempstead (Traffic Regulations No. 1) Order 1963, as amended by the Borough of Hemel Hempstead (Traffic Regulation No. 1) Order 1964.
- The First Schedule of the Borough of Hemel Hempstead (Traffic Regulations No. 1) Order 1970.
- Schedule 3 of the Dacorum Borough Council (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1982.
- Schedule 3 of the Borough of Dacorum (Marlowes, Bridge Street and Waterhouse Street, Hemel Hempstead) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1987.
- Item 21 of the Third Schedule to the Borough of Hemel Hempstead (Traffic Regulation No. 1) Order 1963, as amended by the Borough of Hemel Hempstead (Traffic Order No. 1) Order 1964.

2. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time on the lengths of roads specified in Schedules 1, 2 and 3.

3. Vehicles will be prohibited from waiting between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for a longer period than 30 minutes in any 1 hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4.

Exemptions from Schedules 1, 3 and 4 of the proposed Order will permit waiting for:

- emergency service vehicles;
 - disabled persons' vehicles,
- and where necessary in connection with:
- the maintenance of the road;
 - supply of gas, electricity and water;
 - delivery and collection of postal packets.

Full details of the proposals are in the draft Order, which together with plans showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, may be examined during normal office hours at the Department of Law and Administration

SCHEDULE 1

No waiting at any time

Waterhouse Street, Hemel Hempstead:

- west side;
- east side from junction with Combe Street to a point 92 metres north of the junction with Bridge Street;
- east side from a point 74 metres north of the junction with Bridge Street to a point 41 metres south of Bridge Street.

Bridge Street, Hemel Hempstead, both sides of the western section from the entrance to the Water Gardens car park to its junction with Waterhouse Street.

SCHEDULE 2

No waiting at any time

Waterhouse Street, east side from a point 74 metres north of Bridge Street northwards for 18 metres (the hackney carriage rank).

SCHEDULE 3

No waiting between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays

Waterhouse Street, Hemel Hempstead:

- east side from a point 41 metres south of Bridge Street to a point 9 metres south of the southern entrance to Bank Court.
- east side from a point 24 metres south of the southern entrance to Bank Court southwards for 32 metres;
- east side from a point 88 metres south of the southern entrance to Bank Court southwards to the junction with Moor End Road.

The Borough of Dacorum (Park Lane, Hemel Hempstead) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that Dacorum Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sub-section 1(1) and (2), and 2(3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will have the following effect:

To prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time on the length of road specified in Schedule 1. Exemptions to this Article will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- picking up and setting down passengers;
 - loading and unloading vehicles;
 - emergency service vehicles;
 - disabled persons vehicles;
- and where necessary in connection with:
- the maintenance of the road;
 - supply of gas, electricity and water;
 - delivery and collection of postal packets.
