TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Cynon Valley Borough Council (Un-named Highway adjoining Fifth Avenue, Hirwaun Industrial Estate, Mid Glamorgan) (Stopping-up) Order 1990.

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made the above Order under section 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping-up of the highway described in the Schedule to this notice to facilitate the movement of traffic on the main highway which is to be constructed in accordance with planning permission granted by Cynon Valley Borough Council on 15th February 1990.

Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge of Hirwaun Library, High Street, Hirwaun, Aberdare during 10 a.m. to 1 p.m., 2 p.m. to 5 p.m., Monday and Thursday; 10 a.m. to 1 p.m., 3 p.m. to 6 p.m., Tuesday and Friday; 10 a.m. to 1 p.m., Wednesday and Saturday.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:

- that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971; or
- that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act.

He may within 6 weeks of 2nd August 1990, apply to the High Court for suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE

The highway to the stopped-up is at Hirwaun Industrial Estate in the County of Mid Glamorgan and is that length of unnamed highway which extends from its junction with Fifth Avenue in a general south-easterly direction for a distance of 130 metres. (1 SI)
