THE NEW TOWN OF MILTON KEYNES EXTINGUISHMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY OVER PART OF BROUGHTON ROAD, MILTON KEYNES

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981, proposes to make an order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following route shown coloured red on the map referred to therein:

From a point marked 'A' approximately 30 metres south of the bridge crossing Broughton Brook for a distance of approximately 400 metres in a generally south-westerly direction to a point marked 'B' on the plan approximately 200 metres north-east of Home Farm, Milton Keynes Village.

A map showing the rights of way proposed to be extinguished and the alternative route available may be inspected at the offices of the Milton Keynes Development Corporation, Saxon Court, 502 Avebury Boulevard, Central Milton Keynes MK9 3HS, during normal office hours. Any objection to this proposal must be made in writing clearly stating all the grounds of the objection and addressed to the Secretary of State for the Environment, (Ref: NT/5444/U17/3/6), Room P2/153, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB, not later than 10th September 1990.
