Gloucestershire County Council (Bourton-on-the-Water) (Waiting Restrictions) Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that on 3rd August 1990, the Gloucestershire County Council in pursuance of Regulation 25 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1989, made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is:

To prohibit any vehicle from waiting, loading or unloading at any time in part of High Street.

To prohibit any vehicle from waiting, loading or unloading or between 11 a.m. and 7 p.m. from 1st April-30th September inclusive in part of High Street.

To prohibit any vehicle from waiting, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 7 p.m. in parts of Station Road and Moore Road.

To prohibit any vehicle from waiting, between the hours of 11 a.m. and 7 p.m. in parts of High Street, Rissington Road and Rissington Road cul-de-sac.

To prohibit any vehicle from waiting, between the hours of 11 a.m. and 7 p.m. from 1st April to 30th September inclusive in parts of Station Road, Rissington Road and Victoria Street.

To prohibit any vehicle from waiting at any time in parts of Victoria Street.

To revoke the existing provisions:

(a) Gloucestershire County Council (Various Roads, Bourton-on-the-Water) (General Traffic Regulation) Order, 1986, Schedule II, III, Items 19 and 20 of Schedule IV and Items 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7 and 12 of Schedule V.

(b) The Rural District of North Cotswold Provision of Parking Places Order.

A copy of the Order which will come into effect on 17th August 1990, together with a copy of the relevant plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Gloucester, the County Divisional Offices, Station Road, Bourton-on-the-Water, and at the County Library and News Centre, The Avenue, Bourton-on-the-Water, during the following opening hours:

The Guildford (Off-street Parking Places) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1990

40 m.p.h. Speed Limit in Hitches Lane, Fleet

HART DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Hart (Off-street Parking Places) (Amendment) (No. 1) Order 1990

Notice is hereby given that the Hart District Council, subject to the approval of the Hampshire County Council and the Chief Officer of Police, and in exercise of its powers under sections 35 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, propose to make an Order amending parking charges for car parks under its control; making minor consequential changes to the text of the Order as a result of amended charges, and legislative alterations; and to provide clarity. Briefly, the Order will

(i) increase the charges for the Gurkha Square, Civic Offices and Flagship House Car Parks in Fleet (short stay) to 20p per hour;

(ii) increase the charges for the Church Road and Victoria Road Car Parks, Fleet (medium/long stay) to

30p for up to 2 hours

70p for up to 4 hours
