Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Schedule 12 of the Water Act 1989, that an application has been made to The National Rivers Authority, Anglian Region, by European Cellulose Manufacturers (ECM) Ltd. for consent to discharge up to 67,000 cubic metres per day of treated trade effluent, derived from the manufacture of bleached paper pulp from straw, to the Humber Estuary at National Grid Reference TA 2395 1360 within the Cleethorpes District Council area from ECM Ltd., Straw Pulp Mill, Stallingborough, Humberside.

EAGLE LEVEL ADIT

Notice is given that Yorkshire Water Services Limited is applying to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order (to remain in force for six months) under section 131 of the Water Act 1989, authorising a temporary modification of the obligations at which the Company is subject as respects the discharge of water from Eagle Level Adit, Nr. Pateley Bridge at NGR SE 145653, under the provisions of the Harrogate and Ripon and Pateley Bridge Water Order 1956, the Order if granted would reduce the quantity of water it is obliged to discharge from 909 cubic metres per day (cmd) (200,000 gallons per day (gpd)) to 303 cmd (66,666 gpd) whenever the total flow from the said adit is less than 5,800 cmd (1,276,000 gpd).

KELD HEAD

Notice is given that Yorkshire Water Services Limited is applying to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order (to remain in force for six months) under section 131 of the Water Act 1989, authorising a temporary modification of the restrictions to which the Company is subject as respects the abstraction of water from 2 No. Keld Head boreholes at NGR SE 787844 under the provisions of licence number 2/27/25/128 namely the restriction prohibiting the extraction of more than 7.05 thousand cubic metres per day (tcmd) (1.55 million gallons per day (mgd)) when the combined flow in Lower West Drain and Costa Beck is less than 38.64 tcmd (8.5 mgd) and allowing the extraction of a maximum of 9.09 tcmd (2 mgd) at all other times.

The Order if granted would permit (a) abstraction at the maximum rate of 9.09 tcmd (2 mgd) whenever the combined flow in Lower West Drain and Costa Beck is greater than 17.4 tcmd (3.83 mgd) and (b) a rate of 7.05 tcmd (1.55 mgd) whenever the combined flow is less than 17.4 tcmd (3.83 mgd).

RIVER URE

Notice is given that Yorkshire Water Services Limited is applying to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order (to remain in force for six months) under section 131 of the Water Act 1989, authorising a temporary modification of the restrictions to which the Company is subject as respects the abstraction of water from the River Ure at a site between National Grid references SE 182863 and SE 191860 under the provisions, under the provisions of licence number 2/27/22/214 namely the requirement that, when abstracting water at a rate exceeding 3.27 thousand cubic metres (tcm) but not exceeding 22.7 tcm per day a prescribed flow of 161.7 tcm per day is maintained in the River at a point immediately downstream of the point of abstraction or an equivalent higher flow (taking the amount of abstraction into account) measured at a gauging station upstream of the point of abstraction. The Order if granted would permit the greater of the following:—

(a) An abstraction rate of 3.27 tcm per day at all stages of river flow; or (b) when the total amount of water retained in Thornton Steward reservoir does not exceed 500 tcm an abstraction rate of 6.5 tcm per day whenever the residual river flow is less than 80 tcm per day but greater than 20 tcm per day; or (c) an abstraction rate of 13 tcm per day subject to maintaining a prescribed flow of 80 tcm per day; or (d) an abstraction rate of 22.7 tcm per day subject to maintaining a prescribed flow of 161.7 tcm per day.
