Notice of application for a licence to abstract water and application to vary a licence of right

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the National Rivers Authority, Anglian Region, by E. H. Morris (Stonea) Ltd, of Ancaster Farm, Stonea, March, Cambridgeshire, for a licence to abstract water and to vary licence of right serial number 6/33/53/53/9.

The application is to abstract 7,000,000 gallons per year from April to September in each year for the spray irrigation of agricultural crops from the Forty Foot Drain, Sixteen Foot Drain, District Internal Drains and farm dykes, as indicated on the map at Bensons Farm, Chatteris, Cambridgeshire, Normoor Far, Chatteris, Cambridgeshire and Broad Alder Farm, Chatteris, Cambridgeshire.

The variation is to add additional land and abstraction points at Boots Farm, Stonea, March, Cambridgeshire and to increase the quantities of water as follows: 15,000 gallons per hour (unchanged), but from 100,000 gallons to 150,000 gallons per day and from 2,000,000 to 8,000,000 gallons per year from April to September in each year for the spray irrigation of agricultural crops.
