TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

Land to the rear of No. 120 Moorfield Road Widnes Cheshire

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 247 and section 253 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, if planning permission for residential development on land to the rear of Nos. 120 and 122 Moorfield Road, Widnes is granted, proposes to make an Order the effect of which will be to divert that part of the existing footpath which runs from the north eastern corner of the rear boundary of 120 Moorfield Road, Widnes diagonally over open ground in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 22 yards to a point between the rear boundaries of Nos. 31 and 33 Elkan Road, Widnes (marked A-B on the map); onto a new line from the north-eastern corner of the rear boundary of 120 Moorfield Road running directly south for approximately 12 yards to the south-east corner of the rear boundary of 120 Moorfield Road and then in an easterly direction for approximately 17 yards to a point between the rear boundaries of Nos. 31 and 33 Elkan Road, Widnes (marked A-C-B on the map).

The lines and situations of the existing and proposed diverted footpath are shown on the map annexed to the draft Order.

A copy of the draft Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the offices of Halton Borough Council, Municipal Building, Kingsway, Widnes and may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices during normal office hours.

Any representation or objection to the draft Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary of State for the Environment (Ref.
