#### DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Devon (Various Streets, Ottery St. Mary) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading/Unloading) Order 1990.*

Notice is hereby given that Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

When the Order comes into effect:

- (1) You will not be permitted to leave your vehicle at any time in the following length of road:

*The College:*

North and east side, from a point 21 metres west of the east side of St. Mary's Church steps westwards and northwards to the extent of the public highway including the cul-de-sac end.

West and south side from the cul-de-sac end in a southerly direction for its entire length and then eastwards for 11 metres.

*Millcroft Rise:*

North and east side from its junction with Mill Street eastwards for 14 metres,

North and east side, from a point 46 metres from its junction with Mill Street, eastwards to its junction with Windrush Rise.

South and west side, from its junction with Mill Street east and then southwards for a distance of 67 metres.

*Mill Street*, north side, from the east side of Tar Lane, westwards for a distance of 15 metres.

*Paternoster Row*, south-east side, from a point 35 metres south-east of its junction with North Street, south-west for 10 metres.

*Yonder Street:*

North side, from a point 45 metres east of its junction with Chapel Lane, eastwards for 50 metres.

South side, from a point 133 metres east of its junction with Yonder Close, eastwards for a distance of 75 metres.

South side from a point 10 metres east of its junction with Batt's Lane eastwards for a distance of 10 metres.

*Beech Park*, both sides, from its junction with West Hill Road (B3177) north-west for a distance of 30 metres.

*West Hill Road (B3177)*, both sides, from a point 30 metres north-east of its junction with Beech Park to a point 125 metres south-west of that junction.

- (2) You will not be permitted to leave your vehicle between the hours of 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily in the following length of road:

*Silver Street*, east, west and south sides of War Memorial for their entire length.

- (3) You will not be permitted to load or unload between the hours of 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive, in the following length of road:

*Jesu Street*, north side, from its junction with Broad Street/Tip Hill to its junction with Batts Lane.

- (4) Loading Bays will be provided in the following lengths of road:

*Mill Street*, north side, from the east side of Tar Lane westwards for a distance of 15 metres.

*Jesu Street/Yonder Street*, south side, from a point 5 metres west of its junction with Batts Lane eastwards for 15 metres.

Exemptions in the Order permit waiting for the purposes of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, Post Office services, maintenance of the road, supply of gas, water and electricity, pursuance of statutory powers or duties, taking in petrol, oil or air from a garage. The statutory exemptions for disabled persons are included.

A copy of the draft Order together with the plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during usual office hours at the offices of the East Devon District Council, Knowle, Sidmouth or at the Library, Old Town Hall, Ottery St. Mary.

#### WEST DEVON BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The West Devon Borough Council (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1990*

Notice is hereby given that the West Devon Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 32 to 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be:

- (a) To introduce new commercial vehicle parking charges for commercial vehicles with an unladen weight exceeding 1½ tons the scale of charges to be as follows:

For a period of 5 hours	£1
For a period of over 5 hours and up to 24 hours	£3
For a period in excess of 24 hours	£3 per calendar day

- (b) To introduce new parking tickets to be issued by all ticket machines to show the expiry date and time.

- (c) To increase the standard charge to £20.

- (d) To increase parking charges as follows:

Car park	Charges
Brook Street, Tavistock	10p for 1 hour
	30p for 2 hours
	40p for 3 hours
Bank Square, Tavistock Bedford and Abbey, Tavistock	10p for 1 hour
	20p for 2 hours
	30p for 3 hours
Market Street, Okehampton	60p over 3 hours
	10p for 1 hour
	30p for 2 hours
Riverside, Tavistock and Mill Road, Okehampton	40p for 3 hours
	60p over 3 hours
	30p all day

- (e) To reinstate and enforce all other provisions (including time limits and classes of vehicle) contained in the West Devon Borough Council (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1986.

These proposals shall apply to all the public car parks specified in the Schedule below. Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with the relevant maps, the Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order and a copy of the West Devon Borough Council (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1986 may be inspected between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Friday at:
