#### WATER ACT 1989—SCHEDULE 12

##### Notice of application for consent for the purposes of section 108

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Schedule 12 of the above Act, that an application has been made to the National Rivers Authority by Severn Trent Water Ltd. for consent to discharge settled storm sewage and up to 970 cubic metres per day of treated sewage effluent to a tributary of the Ley Brook at National Grid Ref. SO 7394 1906 and SO 7400 1906 respectively, from Huntley Water Reclamation Works, Gloucestershire.

The works are to be modified in that storm tanks are to be provided, with reduced flows to full treatment to prevent hydraulic overloading.
