NATIONAL RIVERS AUTHORITY—SEVERN-TRENT REGION

Notice of application to vary a licence to abstract water

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the National Rivers Authority by Wilfred Maddocks Ltd. of Chadwell Grange, Newport, Shropshire to vary licence serial number 18/54/4/592 to abstract water from the Bunter Sandstone at NGR SJ 7833 1411. The variation applied for is: An increase in the maximum daily abstraction from 1,364 cubic metres to 2,290 cubic metres. An increase in the maximum annual abstraction from 81,818 cubic metres to 190,909 cubic metres. To increase the area of the land on which the water may be used.

A copy of the application and of any map, plan or other document submitted with it may be inspected free of charge at Chadwell Grange, Newport, Shropshire at all reasonable hours during the period beginning on 8th November 1990 and ending on 6th December 1990.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

GOSPORT BOROUGH COUNCIL

Traffic Regulation Order

Notice is hereby given that the Gosport Borough Council as agents for the Hampshire County Council made the following Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to 3 and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

Borough of Gosport (Leesland Road|Carlyle Road) (Prohibition of Waiting at any Time) (Amendment) (No.25) Order 1990

The effect of the Order will be to extend the prohibition of waiting on the northern side of Leesland Road for a short distance in a westerly direction from its junction with Lees Lane, and for a short distance in an easterly direction on the northern side of Carlyle Road, from its junction with Lees Lane.

Borough of Gosport (Gregson Avenue) (Prohibition of Waiting at any Time) (Amendment) (No.27) Order 1990

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting on the south-east side of Gregson Avenue from its junction with the access road to a point 14 metres south-west of its junction with Nobes Avenue, and for a distance of 7 metres on both sides of Nobes Avenue, from its junction with Gregson Avenue.

Borough of Gosport (Dock Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) (No.29) Order 1990

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the eastern side of Dock Road, from its junction with the Asda Access Road for a short distance along the frontage of Automech Garage, and for a short distance on the north and south side of the Asda Access Road, from its junction with Dock Road. On the western side of Dock Road, just south of its junction with South Street in a southerly direction for a length of 50 metres.

Waiting will also be prohibition in Dock Road on its western side, between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday, from the northern end of Tony Knight (Car Sales) in a southerly direction to a point just south of the junction with the Asda Access Road.

Borough of Gosport (Norfolk Road) (Limited Waiting) (No.26) Order 1990

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting for a period of more than two hours, or a return within less than 4 hours, between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., within the laybys on the western side of Norfolk Road.

Borough of Gosport (Cambridge Road) (Prohibition of Waiting at any Time) (Amendment) (No.28) Order 1990

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting on the north side of Cambridge Road from its junction with Military Road, to a point east of the entrance to HMS Sultan, and on south side of Cambridge Road, from a short distance either side of the entrance to HMS Sultan.

Copies of the Order and relevant map showing the lengths of roads concerned together with the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the office of the undersigned during the usual office hours.

Objections to the proposals should be sent in writing, stating the grounds thereof, to the undersigned by 27th November 1990.

HORSHAM DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Horsham District (Off-street Parking Places) General (Amendment) Order 1990

Notice is hereby given, that Horsham District Council has made the above-named Order pursuant to sections 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and all other enabling powers the effect of which is to detail the conditions that will operate for the parking of vehicles in Piries Place car park Horsham.

The classes of vehicles which may wait at the car parks, are motor cars, motor cycles and invalid carriages only, and the hours and day of operation and charges for the use of the car parks, are given below:

(1) This Order shall come into operation on 16th November 1990, and may be cited as the Horsham District (Off-street Parking Places), General (Amendment) Order 1990.

(2) Piries Place car park (multi-storey)

Days of operation, all days.

Hours of operation, all hours.

Maximum period of waiting, 3 hours in any 24 consecutive hours.

Charging hours, Monday to Saturday 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. (except Bank Holidays).

Charges: 1 £.

Not more than 1 hour 20p

Over 1 hour but not more than 2 hours 40p

Over 2 hours but not more than 3 hours 70p

Excess Charge:

£10-00 if paid within 14 days or £20-00 if paid after that time.

NOTTINGHAM COUNTY COUNCIL

The Nottinghamshire County Council. (A6006, Sutton Bonington|Normanton-on-Soar) (De-restriction) Order 1990 (12).

Notice is hereby given, that the Nottinghamshire County Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be (with respect of roads at Sutton Bonington and Normanton-on-Soar in the Borough of Rushcliffe):

(1) The A6006 Road, extending from a point 70 metres north-east of the centre line of Park Lane junction in a south-westerly direction to a point 71 metres south-west of the centre line of Moor Lane junction, a total distance of 221 metres.

(2) Park Lane, extending from its junction with the A6006 Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 196 metres.
