will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the A650 Bradford Road, Shipley extending on its south-western side from—

- (a) a point 10 metres south-east to a point 23 metres north-west of the produced south-eastern kerb-line of Avondale Road;
- (b) a point 10 metres south-east of the produced south-eastern kerb-line of Marlborough Road to its junction with the southeastern kerb-line of Marlborough Road;
- (c) a point 26 metres north-west to a point 41 metres north-west of the produced north-western kerb-line of Marlborough Road.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order so that any vehicle may wait for so long as may be necessary to enable-

- (i) loading or unloading of goods;
- (ii) building, industrial or demolition operations to be carried out;
- (iii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iv) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of road so specified or the statutory services;
- (v) the vehicle to be used for police, fire brigade, ambulance, local authority or water authority purposes.

Exceptions are also included for disabled persons' vehicles for a period not exceeding two hours provided that the vehicle displays, in the relevant position, a disabled person's badge and a parking disc.
