TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE EXTINGUISHMENT OF VEHICULAR RIGHTS
(COUNTY OF HERTFORDSHIRE) (NO.) ORDER 199

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, on the application of the Welwyn Hatfield Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 249 of the above Acts to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on part of Stonehills, Welwyn Garden City, Hertfordshire.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of that highway by vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
- (b) in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the said length of highway of any sewer, main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984; or where the vehicle is:
- (c) a security vehicle servicing the premises of the National Westminster Bank plc, 13 Stonehills, Welwyn Garden City.
