(Restriction of Waiting on Bus Stops) Order 199 and the Buckinghamshire County Council (Central Milton Keynes) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 199 under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the above-mentioned Act of 1984.

- 2. The general effect of the Orders would be to impose a system of parking controls and restrictions in the Central Milton Keynes and Loughton areas of the county of Buckinghamshire in the streets and parts of the streets listed in Schedules 1 to 8 of this notice.
  - 3. The Parking Places Orders would:

(a) designate parking places on the highways specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this notice for the vehicles authorised by the Orders to be left in those parking places and provides that the type of parking place so designated would be as set out in column 2 of that Schedule and the hours of operation of the parking places would be as set out in column 3 of that Schedule;

(b) specify, in respect of the "pay and display" and free parking places, that passenger vehicles (12 seats or less), goods vehicles, motor cycles and invalid carriages may be left therein, in respect of the residents' parking places, that vehicles displaying a valid residents' permit issued by the Council may be left therein, in respect of the business users' parking places that vehicles displaying a valid business users' permit issued by the Council may be left therein; and in respect of disabled persons parking places, disabled persons' vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge may be left therein;

(c) provide that residents' permits would be issued by the Council on application being made by any person who is the owner of a passenger vehicle (12 seat or less), a goods vehicle not more than 3.5 tonnes gross weight, a motor cycle or an invalid carriage and that business users' permits would be issued by the Council on application being made by any person who is the owner of a dual-purpose vehicle or a vehicle mentioned previously in this

paragraph and:

(i) in the case of a residents' parking place, resides in the street and parts of streets, listed in Schedule 2 to this Notice; and

(ii) in the case of a business users' parking place, occupies or carries out business at premises in any street or part of a street within the area described in Schedule 3 to this Notice;

## ((d) specify that:

(i) in the "pay and display" parking places (except those on the north-east side of Secklow Gate, immediately outside the Food Centre) the initial charge would be at the rate of 10 pence for 20 minute and the maximum initial period would be either 2 hours or 3 hours as the case may be and in the "pay and display" parking places on the north-east side of Secklow Gate immediately outside the Food Centre, the initial charge would be 10 pence for 30 minutes;

(ii) in respect of the residents' and business users' parking places, the charge for permit would be £15 for permits expiring at the end of 12 months running from the beginning of the

month in which they are issued;

(iii) in respect of the "pay and display" parking places, the excess charge—payable to the Council—would be £20; the excess charge period would be 1 hour and the period during which a vehicle may not return to a parking place would be 1 hour;

- (e) provide that certain vehicles may wait free of charge in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight, to load or unload and vehicles left by specified disabled persons.
- 4. The Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting Order would— (a) impose waiting restrictions on vehicles:

(i) at any time in the streets and parts of the streets specified

in Schedule 4 to this notice; and

(ii) between 10 a.m. and 11 a.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the street and part of the street specified in Schedule 5 to this notice;

(b) exemptions to the order would permit:

- (i) waiting with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden;
- (ii) waiting for so long as may be necessary for persons to board or alight, for goods to be loaded or unloaded, for enabling works to be carried out and in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; and
- (iii) the waiting of disabled persons' vehicles in accordance with the "orange badge" scheme.
- 5. The 24 Hour Main Carriageway Clearway Order would impose clearway restrictions on vehicles at any time in parts of the street specified in Schedule 6 to this Notice. Exemptions to the Order would permit:

- (i) waiting for enabling works to be carried out and in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; and
- (ii) a vehicle performing a local bus service to wait in a bus stop area.
- 6. The Restriction of Waiting on Bus Stops Order would prohibit any vehicle, other than a vehicle performing a local bus service whilst picking up or setting down passengers, from waiting on a bus stop in the streets specified in Schedule 7 to this notice.
- 7. The Prohibition of Entry Order would prohibit any vehicle other than a vehicle equipped to carry 12 or more passengers from entering that length of street specified in Schedule 8 to this notice.
- 8. Copies of the proposed Orders, other relevant Orders which need to be revoked, plans indicating the locations and effects of the Orders and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the orders can be inspected during normal office hours until 4th January 1991 at the County Hall, Aylesbury, Buckinghamshire, or the Milton Keynes Library, 555 Silbury Boulevard, Saxon Gate East, Central Milton Keynes, Buckinghamshire.
- 9. Any objections or other representations about the proposed Orders should be sent in writing to the undersigned by 4th January 1991 and must specify the grounds on which they are made.
