TENDER FOR STERLING TREASURY BILLS

THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAYS (COUNTY OF HERTFORDSHIRE) (NO 6) ORDER 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, on the application of the Council of the City and District of St. Albans, he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Hertfordshire) (No. 6) Order 1990" authorising the stopping up of part of Keyfield Terrace, St. Albans, Hertfordshire to enable development consisting of the construction of a new entrance/ exit for the No. 2 Car Park at Keyfield Terrace, St. Albans to be carried out in accordance with planning permission deemed to have been granted under Part III of the said Act.
