

- 64 *The Woodlands*, south side from a point 30 feet (9.1 metres) west of the west side of its junction with Hollybank Road to a point 91 feet (27.8 metres) east of the east side of that junction.
- 65 *The Woodlands*, south side from a point 24 feet (7.3 metres) west of the west side of its junction with Hazel Road to a point 33 feet (10 metres) east of the east side of that junction.
- 66 *The Woodlands*, south side from a point 54 feet (16.5 metres) west of the west side of its southerly junction with Fearnley Road to its junction with Clifton Road.
- 67 *Whetstone Lane*, north-east side from a point 45 feet (13.7 metres) north-west of the north-west side of its junction with Maple Street to a point 45 feet (13.7 metres) south-east of the south-east side of that junction.
- 68 *Whetstone Lane*, east side from a point 45 feet (13.7 metres) north of the north side of its junction with Cedar Street to a point 45 feet (13.7 metres) south of the south side of that junction.
- 69 *Whetstone Lane*, east side from a point 15 feet (4.6 metres) south of the south side of its junction with *The Woodlands* for a distance of 30 feet (9.1 metres) measured in a southerly direction.
- 70 *Whetstone Lane*, east side from a point 45 feet (13.7 metres) south of the south side of its junction with *The Woodlands* to a point 45 feet (13.7 metres) north of the north side of that junction.

SCHEDULE 3

- 1. *The Village, Upton*, north side from a point 45 feet (13.7 metres) west of its westerly junction with Church Road to a point 45 feet (13.7 metres) east of its easterly junction with Church Road.
- 2. *Church Road*, both sides from its southerly junction with *The Village* for a distance of 45 feet (13.7 metres) in a northerly direction.

SCHEDULE 4

No Waiting at Any Time

Mount Pleasant Road, north-west side from a point (14.7 metres) north-east of its junction with Mount Road to a point 12 metres south-west of that junction.

Mount Pleasant Road, south-east side from a point (14.7 metres) north-east of its junction with Kirkway to a point 42 metres south-west of that junction.

Kirkway, both sides from its junction with Mount Pleasant Road for a distance of 10 metres in a south-easterly direction.

Mount Road, north-east side from its junction with Mount Pleasant Road for a distance of 20 metres in a north-easterly direction.

Mount Road, south-west side from its junction with Mount Pleasant Road for a distance of 10 metres in a north-westerly direction.

Hose Side Road, north-east side from a point 11 metres north-west of its junction with Mount Pleasant Road for a distance of 53 metres in a north-westerly direction.

The effect of Order V will be to make the area of land in West Kirby bounded by Orrysdale Road and the Fire Station (the Concourse Car Park) an off-Street car park for vehicles under 1,525 kilograms at the times and at the charges specified in the following Schedule 5.
